High Jump will not be run at this event. Only students who meet the Diocesan criteria (**Documentation** from Little Athletics or a certified athletics sporting body is required.) Please see me for further information.

As with all age groups, the top six competitors will compete in the finals on the day for 800m, discus, long jump and shot put. Notification will be posted next week and class teachers will assist with notifying students if they have qualified for events. All other students will participate in novelty and team house events.

The Sports Committee, in liaison with the Principal, determine the squad members that represent Chisholm at Zone and Diocesan championships.

Children are to wear their **sports uniform** to school on the carnival day, however, they are encouraged to wear t-shirts, ribbons etc to match their **House colour**. Please ensure that your child has a supply of sunscreen, a hat and plenty of water. Looking forward to the day!
