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Bring Your Own Chromebook for 21st Century Learning

Dear Parents and Carers,

Technology is an integral part of our lives today, in the workplace, at home and in our learning spaces. At Chisholm, we are looking at ways we can further integrate technology with our students' learning experiences and the skills they will need to develop for 21st Century learning. This offer is for students from Year 2 to Year 6.

This is not compulsory. No Chisholm student will be left out of instructional activities if they do not have their own device. They will still be able to access and utilise the school's IT equipment. Having their own device means a student can seamlessly access their digital work activities from home as well as at school.

Chisholm Catholic Primary uses Chromebooks as the preferred device. They are less expensive than an iPad or laptop, are sturdy and durable, and the Google apps that can be accessed provide the opportunity for students to work collaboratively with their teachers and peers, and develop their ICT skills.

We have an agreement with a Catholic Education supplier for parents & carers to be able to purchase a Chromebook for their children at a discounted price. Purchasing through our supplier ensures that the Chromebook will have the correct specifications as well as the Google Management Console License. <u>You will not be able to purchase a chromebook from a different supplier</u>, as it will not be properly configured for licensing and use within Parramatta Diocesan schools.


